

## 25 - Die Terminals unter X

```
rxvt -bg lithcyan -T "Marty" -geometry 80x25 (rechts Oben) -e su marty
```

To change font size at start :

```
rxvt -fn font fonts are: 7x14 6x10 6x13 8x13 9x15 10x20
```

To change font dynamically use: **Shift-Grey+** and **Shift-Grey-**

```
xterm -sb -rightbar -bg lithcyan -T "Marty" -geometry 80x24-0 (rechts Oben) -e su joe
```

**Note** : the fonts settings parameters of **rxvt** are also good for **xterm**.

**Note**: **-geometry** option for many programs works as follows:

```
-geometry <Hsize>x<Vsize><Hpos><Vpos>
```

<Hsize> and <Vsize> are numbered in characters

<Hpos> '+' is down, '-' is up (in screen pixels)

eg. +10 is down 10 pixels

<Vpos> '+' is right, '-' is left (in screen pixels)

eg. +10 is right 10 pixels

### examples:

```
-geometry 1x1+0+0
```

1 char Horiz, 1char vert, top left corner

```
-geometry 5x20-10+30
```

5 char Horiz,

20char vert,

top right corner

10 Pixels Horiz.to the left

30 Pixels vertical down

```
-geometry 80x25+30-40
```

80 char Horiz

25 char vert

Bottom left corner

30 Pixels right

40 Pixels up

```
-geometry 132x40-400-300
```

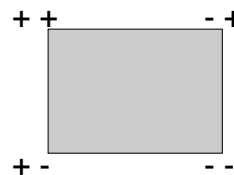
132 char Horiz

40char vert

from bottom corner

400 Pixels left

300 Pixels up
